

# Horse Collar

Horse Collar is played using only 12 Frames

You **use** only three discs of each color

Your partner is the player on the same end of the court as you are

You draw for a new partner for each of 3 games.

The object is to accumulate the most points, no defensive plays,

Before any Points may be scored one of the partners must shoot a disc in the -10 (Kitchen) within the 1<sup>st</sup> 2 frames. That then counts as a Plus ten, and regular scoring begins. Future -10 counts as ten off.

The Combined score of the partner's is added up for the 12 frames

It really is a great test of skill, and practice for the hammer in tournaments

\$1.00 is collected from each player, and paid out Prize money to either the top three or four players depending on how many players there are, then, a dollar is paid out to the next highest scores until the entry money is exhausted.
