

LEE COUNTY SHUFFLEBOARD CLUB
MINUTES FOR GENERAL MEETING ON MARCH 3, 2018

The meeting was called to order at 11:30 a.m. by John Holder, President.

Minutes from the previous General Meeting were read by John Eck, Secretary.

Rita Wilson, Treasurer, presented the financial report. The report is posted on the Bulletin Board.

John Holder recognized the many people who helped out with various jobs this year.

John Holder talked about repainting the courts. The repainting did not occur as planned last summer because of a problem with the selected contractor. Lee County has selected Southwest Courts to do the court repainting. The courts will be locked up starting April 1 as the court painting is expected to be done in April. A sign will be posted when daily play can resume.

People from Lee County are deciding on the design for the court roof. The roof will be in this year's Lee County budget.

LCSC is getting pressured by the Florida Shuffleboard Association and the Southern District about the condition of our tournament disks. John Holder said that the club should buy 24 sets of new disks for tournament play, and the current tournament disks would be used for daily play. A discussion was held about what kind of disks to buy. The disks can be finished by Jim Miller at an additional cost of \$12 a set. John Klinger moved that LCSC buy 24 sets of disks and finish them for a cost not to exceed \$2,000. Motion was seconded by John Eck and passed.

Wally Thyssen asked for helpers for the Masters Tournament to be held at LCSC on March 22-24, 2018.
